The event is designed to highlight the results of the main experiments, identified innovations, introduced technologies and practices aimed to maximize profitability, sustainability, and biodiversity, taking into consideration the challenges that economic stakeholders and operators of the sector are facing, mainly limited resources and environmental constraints.
